BAND SPRING TRIP 2010

DATES

All students going on the trip must have a **PERMISSION FORM, BEHAVIOR CONTRACT, AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION AND CONSENT FORM** completed and signed no later than Wednesday, April, 7th, 2010. **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO GO ON THE TRIP WITHOUT THESE FORMS.**

We will be leaving Sullivan South High School on **Wednesday, April 7th, 2010** at 7:00 P.M. We will load buses at 6:30. **Any person, for whatever reason, who is not at the school for loading and/or departure, will be left, and no money will be refunded.** We will arrive in Orlando at approximately 9:30 AM on Thursday, April 8th. We will be leaving Orlando approximately **8:00AM on Sunday, April 11th.** We will arrive at Sullivan South High School the evening of **April 11th** at approximately **10:00 PM.**

GENERAL TRIP RULES

1. You must carry your schedule at all times. You must follow it exactly.
2. No one is allowed to wander around on their own for any reason.
3. Any adult chaperone should also follow all rules and report any student who breaks any rules to the director immediately. It is very important that all adults on the trip abide by the rules and decisions made by the director, even if you don't necessarily agree with them.
4. No alcoholic beverages of any kind may be consumed by anyone at any time.
5. The director, Sullivan South High School, and/or chaperones are not responsible for any items belonging to the student, including cameras, jackets, back packs, meal tickets, money, etc.
6. All school rules will be in effect and enforced. **The director reserves the right to restrict any student from any trip activity for behavior reasons or for being uncooperative. Students who demonstrate illegal or immoral behavior will be remanded to the**

proper authorities. Parents will be contacted and will be responsible for coming to Orlando to pick up their child immediately. Examples include but are not limited to shoplifting, vandalism, and inappropriate sexual conduct.

SPENDING MONEY

The meals that students are responsible for include: breakfast on Thursday morning before we arrive in Orlando, dinner on Thursday, and dinner on Friday, dinner on Saturday, and lunch and dinner on Sunday on the way home. Lunch and dinner on Sunday will be fast food on the way home. Students will need some extra money for soft drinks and snacks plus any other souvenirs or items not covered in the package that they might want to purchase. It is recommended that each person bring an additional \$100.00 with them to cover unexpected expenses. **If you are bringing more than \$100.00, it is strongly recommended that you purchase travelers checks.**

CHARTER BUS RULES AND PROCEDURES

It is extremely important, for the safety of everyone that we all follow the rules and procedures when riding the charter buses.

1. No smoking or tobacco products.
2. No chewing gum. Snacks and soft drinks will be allowed but they must be properly disposed of. Drinks **MUST** have screw lids.
3. Use trash bags for trash, paper, etc. **No trash on the floor**---pick up after yourself.
4. Sit properly in seats.
DON'T: Stand on seats, get up on your knees in seats, hang or lean over the backs of seats, or sit on the arms of the seats.
5. Avoid moving in aisles when coach is in motion.
6. Keep noise at a reasonable level. No screaming is allowed. Keep in mind there are other people on the bus you are riding. **Be Polite.**
7. You may bring video games and even small walkmans but you must use headphones.
8. Follow all school rules and regulations at all times.
9. You must ride the bus you are assigned to at all times. **No switching of buses will be allowed for any reason.**

NOTE: Any person damaging anything will be held financially responsible.

Hotel Rules

1. No students should be in another student's room for any reason.
NO BOYS ALLOWED IN GIRLS ROOMS-AND NO GIRLS ALLOWED IN BOYSROOM!!!
2. 10:00 PM – is the start of **Quiet Time**.
3. Room keys will be issued to the director. Lost keys can only be replaced by the director.
4. No student should leave his or her room after curfew – 11:00 PM. Curfew may be changed by the hotel.
5. Room damage and missing articles will be charged to the group. The director will in turn charge all persons responsible. If the person responsible can not be determined, all persons in the room will be charged.
6. Make sure if you need something outside of the hotel, take care of it before curfew, or see your chaperone.
7. Make sure you are on time for all group meals.
8. You may bring your cell phone or use the phones on site.
9. Please **DO NOT** order food from a pizza place or etc. to have it delivered – If you need something to eat and it not time to eat, check with chaperone. We (chaperones) usually keep something extra for the student to eat.

PACKING LIST

1. Six complete changes of clothes. Remember! Include a hoodie, light weight jacket, slacks or jeans in case of any cool weather.
2. Bath/Hygiene accessories (Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, Toothpaste, Toothbrush, etc.)
3. Pillow and blanket for bus trip.
4. Disposable camera. Please do not bring expensive/nice cameras on the band trips
5. Hat, Sunscreen, and Sun Glasses
6. Bathing Suits ...**Lets keep it modest.**
7. Money for meals plus any additional spending money you wish to bring.

8. Comfortable Walking Shoes (An extra pair might be a good idea)
9. IF YOU HAVE PERScription MEDICINE---IT MUST BE IN A ZIP LOCK BAG WITH DIRECTIONS AND YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THE FRONT OF IT. THIS MUST BE GIVEN YOUR CHILD'S CHAPERONE----THURSDAY UPON ARRIVAL AND PRIOR TO LOADING THE BUS. NO EXCEPTIONS!

You may take on a suitcase, one carry on, and a soft lunch box/cooler.

CHAPERONES

1. Students need to check in with their chaperones at Disney once during the day.
2. Chaperones will need to check roll each night to make sure that their students are in their room before lights out.
3. Chaperones should help check roll before departure from all locations, including every stop to and from Orlando.
